



## Southern Illinois IceHawks

### 2011 5-on-5 Spring League Rules

-Ice Time for Games are 50 minutes in length. There will be a 3 minute warm-up. All three periods will be run time, and will be 12 minutes in duration. The clock will only be stopped for PENALTIES, ICING and SERIOUS INJURIES. With 10 minutes left in Ice Time the clock will be set to 5 minutes. If tied the game will end in a 3 player per team shootout. If still tied the game will end tied. (No player that scored in that game will be allowed to shoot until all players who haven't scored shoot)

(If the game is not tied and time permits then the game will still have a 3 player shootout for fun)

-No timeouts.

-There will be NO CHECKING at the Bantam, PeeWee or Squirt level.

-No player will be allowed to score more than 3 goals per game. (Goals after 3 will not be counted) This is to promote passing and playmaking and ensure every player is involved in each game.

-All MINOR penalties will result in a penalty shot. MAJOR penalties, such as checking from behind, will result in a penalty shot and the offending player sitting the appropriate time. A game misconduct could result in further disciplinary action by the SIH Spring Hockey Committee and SIH BOD. If a coach is ejected from a game for any reason, that coach will be removed from the team for the remainder of the session and possibly face further disciplinary action from the SIH BOD.

-Score sheets are the responsibility of the HOME TEAM, and must be turned in after the game.

-Each Team will supply 1 parent for the scorekeeping booth. One will keep score and one will run the clock.
